BYLAW 2

HONORARY MEMBERS

The Club shall be able to appoint Honorary Membership to persons who are thought worthy. This class of membership shall be in addition to those defined in the Rules.

A person may be made an Honorary Member by the President, or by resolution of the Committee.

Honorary Membership shall be bestowed for a period of one year, with extension being allowed by resolution of the Committee annually. There shall be no limit to the number of times such membership may be renewed.

The number of Honorary Members in the Club shall be limited to five at any time.

No entry fee or annual fee is payable.

An Honorary Member shall have rights equal to ordinary members of the Club, except for the following:

- *An Honorary Member has no voting rights.*
- *An Honorary Member is not eligible to be an office bearer.*
- *An Honorary Member shall not be entitled to apply Conditional Registration ("Club Plates") to a car.*
